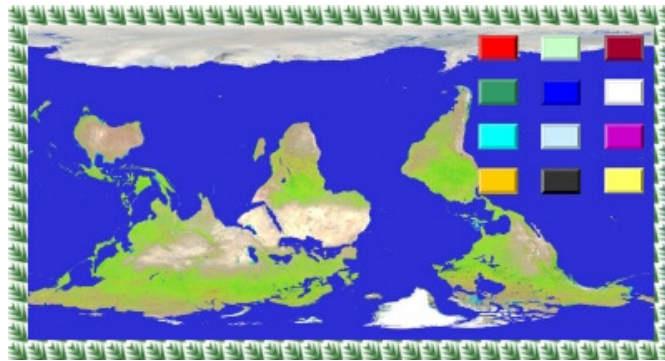


12-12-12 Membership Certificate

joined the membership of the 12-12-12 organisation to participate in the 12-12-12 initiative and agreed to the following:

- I agree that all human beings regardless of tribal origin are equal.
- I fundamentally agree with the UN Declaration on Human Rights.
- I believe it is possible that war and extreme poverty can be eliminated within a few years and would like the 200,000 men and women who collectively rule the World to find the time, money and solutions to make this happen as soon as possible.
- In the next 12 months I will do my best to inform 12 other people that I know, about 12-12-12. (Ideally one of whom is a journalist or has contact with the media).
- If my health permits, I will acquire an organ donor card (or equivalent, as used in my Tribal State) within 36 days and carry it whenever practically possible. I will inform my closest relatives that I am doing so, so that they know of my wishes in case of my death.
- Every Thursday evening, circumstances permitting, if I eat a meal with others, I will place an empty chipped bowl upside down on the table during the duration of the meal. This non-religious simple act will serve as a symbolism to remind others that there are millions of children around the World who regularly go to bed hungry.
- I will keep an historic record for my future descendants wherever they may be living in the cosmos, of my family's personal contribution in helping the Human race become "Many tribes, One people, One planet".

Rules

Hint: Persuade the teenagers in the house to befriend someone who is of a different race and religion who has relatives that need gardening or home improvement help and swap jobs once a month.

1. If you can get any teenager to do anything add 20% for each hour they spend.
2. Add 20% for each hour spent if the beneficiary is from another racial Tribe or has a different skin colour.
3. Add 30% for each hour spent if the beneficiary is from another religious Tribe and both of your families are devout.
4. Add 10% for each hour spent if the work involves gardening or home improvements.
5. Deduct 50% for each hour spent if the work involves a close relative.
6. Work involving your own household does not count, unless your parent(s) or guardian(s) says so.
7. Payment is not allowed: This is a Community Support Card not a factory timesheet. Small tips or gifts of food and drink are fine.
8. For security, peace of mind and family bonding it is preferable for the whole family to undertake voluntary work together at the same time and at the same place.
9. **Never**, ever, ever should children undertake a job alone or without parental approval.
10. **Never**, ever, ever should someone old or vulnerable allow a stranger(s) to undertake jobs.
11. Local schools in liaison with local social workers can become the local register of those needing help.
12. Define additional rules for your family as appropriate.
